Idilico is Pomum Cellars' sister brand focusing exclusively on Spanish varietal wines grown in Washington State. Idilico is the name of a famous Bull that performed in the Barcelona Bullfight Ring in 2008. He performed so well and was so "brave" that it was pardoned and spared from the Matador's sword. Needless to say this is a very rare occurrence and a great victory for this magnificent creature. The goal for Idilico wines, is to bring to the consumer's attention the potential of Spanish varietals in the great Washington State vineyards. Our first white is a beautiful Albariño to which we will follow with Garnacha, Tempranillo, Monastrell and Graciano. Down the road we hope to showcase Verdejo, Viura, Mencía and others.

2013 Idilico Garnacha

Our latest vintage of Garnacha produced under the Idilico label comes from some of the best vineyards for this sun loving grape, Oasis Vineyard near Benton City, Art DenHoed Vineyard in north Sunnyside and Upland Vineyards on Snipes Mountain. All are warmer sites within the larger Yakima Valley AVA where Mediterranean varieties excel.

Fermented in small stainless steel tanks and barrel aged in neutral French oak Puncheons for 12 months. Alcohol is 14.7%, TA 5.3 g/l, PH 3.58. The wine exhibits aromas of caramel, juicy red fruit, jam and hints of citrus. In the palate the wine is full bodied with luscious mouthfeel and a lingering finish. **Only 240 cases produced. \$20.00 Retail**
